

### **DEFINATIONS AND INTERPRETATION**

As used in this Memorandum of Understanding, the expressions below shall have the following meanings, unless the context otherwise requires:

'LBMPs' means Leva Bhatrumandal, Pimpale Saudagar, Pune 411027.

'SMCC' means Shirish Madhukarrao Chaudhari College Jalgaon – 425001.

"Confidential Information" means any information, however it is conveyed, that relates to business, affairs, developments, trade secrets, know-how, personnel and suppliers of the Parties, including intellectual property rights, together with all information derived from the above, and any other information clearly designated as being confidential (whether or not it is marked as "confidential") or which ought reasonably to be considered to be confidential:

"Memorandum of Understanding" means this agreement, comprised of Clauses hereto:

"Default" means any breach of the obligations of the relevant Party (including but not limited to fundamental breach or breach of fundamental term) or any other default, act, omission, negligence or statement of the relevant party, its employees, servants, agents or Sub contractors in connection with or in relation to be the subject-matter of this Memorandum of Understanding and in respect of which such Party is liable to the others;

"Disputes" means any dispute, difference or question of interpretation arising out of this Memorandum of Understanding;

"Dispute Resolution Procedure" means the dispute resolution will be on mutual concern basis;

"Effective Date" means the date of this Memorandum of Understanding.

"Escalation Procedure" means the escalation procedure will be on mutual basis;

"Force Majeure Event" Neither parties shall be liable to the other for any failure, inability, or delay in performing here under if caused by any cause beyond the reasonable control of the party so failing, including, without limitation, an Act of God, war, strike, or fire; but due diligence shall be used in curing such cause and in resuming performance.

"Issue" means any disagreement between the Parties;

"Neutral Advisor" means an independent third Party who determines the categorization of Dispute as set out if happen;

## **GENERAL**

A reference to any statute, enactment, order, regulation or other similar instrument shall be constructed as a reference to the statute, enactment, order, regulation or instrument as amended by any subsequent statute, enactment, order regulation or instrument or as contained in any subsequent re-enactment thereof.

The parties shall comply with any express obligation in this Memorandum of Understanding to comply with any document, statute enactment, order regulation or other similar instrument that is referenced in this Memorandum of Understanding.

Headings are included in this Memorandum of Understanding for ease of reference only and shall not affect the interpretation or construction of this Memorandum of Understanding.

References to Clauses are unless otherwise provided, references to clauses of this Memorandum of Understanding.

Except as otherwise expressly provided in this Memorandum of Understanding, all remedies available to each Party under this Memorandum of Understanding are cumulative and may be exercised concurrently or separately and the exercise of any one remedy shall not exclude the exercise of any other remedy.

Each Party agrees that it will take reasonable steps to mitigate any losses which it suffers in connection with this Memorandum of Understanding.

Each Party shall remain responsible for all acts and omissions of its Subcontractors and all acts and omissions of those employed or engaged by its Subcontractors as if they were its own.

## **DURATION OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

This MOU is effective upon the day and date last signed and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties to this MOU and the governing bodies of the parties respective and shall remain in full force. This MOU may be terminate, without cause, with minimum of 3months prior written notice by either party, which shall be delivered by hand or by certified mail to the address listed above.

## **GENERAL OBLIGATIONS**

The Parties shall abide by the terms of the term, which defines the responsibilities and requirements of the Parties with respect to the product/service.

The Parties understand that each party itself will meet any financial considerations associated with the required forms of collaboration under this Memorandum of Understanding.

In any cases of discontinuance, the Parties will honor respective agreed commitments either via the accepted arrangements or via agreed alternatives negotiated at that point.

Few ideas from anyone within this chain or outside the chain may be developed & intellectual property rights & wealth may be created from such product/technology through this initiative. All parties involved in such rights & wealth should get reasonable credits & share from the all gains. Stakeholders include original idea holder, LBMPs, Involved College, & / or Involved CICS.

Changes / alterations / addition / deletion in terms & content of this agreement can be affected with prior consent of all concerned parties.

## **THE PURPOSE**
